Latino Leadership Programs will be more effective and have greater impact when directors and staff participate in leadership development at the highest level and use this knowledge to improve their programs. Through a partnership with the prestigious Center for Creative Leadership (CCL), LIDERAMOS is offering eight Fellowships to Latino Leadership Program directors and staff in 2020. The fellows **individually** attend a one-week Leadership Development Program at CCL - a premier leadership program that provides powerful tools to maximize results-driven impact and inspires creative thinking that leads to action.

The Fellowship includes:

1. One-week Leadership Development Program at CCL
 - Fellows select a CCL site they prefer – they must attend before August 2020

2. Special access to workshops at LIDERAMOS Symposium
 - Fellows receive admission to an exclusive workshop that provides a Latino lens on assessments & evaluations
 - Fellows are recognized and awarded certificates at the LIDERAMOS National Symposium
3. Continued training and building techniques
 - Fellows advance their skills by meeting virtually and participating in Lideramos leadership webinars
 - Fellows receive access to prominent presenters including a Coaching for Success session

Selection and Timeline:

Interested candidates must have the following qualification:

- Be a director or staff person that works with a Latino Leadership Program or be part of a leadership team that desires to start a program in their community.
- Have at least 2-3 years of experience working in the leadership arena and a minimum of a 4-year track record of community service exemplifying a leadership commitment.
- Agree to participate in follow up virtual conversations and attend the National Latino Leadership Symposium in San Antonio Sept. 23-26.

Tuition and Scholarships:

- One-week Leadership Development Program: \$2000.00 – for organizations with budgets over \$1 million - includes training, materials, meals, webinars, Symposium access, and technical assistance
- One-week Leadership Development Program: \$1500.00 – for organizations with budgets under \$1 million – includes training, materials, meals, webinars, Symposium access, and technical assistance

*Fellows pay travel and hotel expenses at the CCL site. Partial scholarships may be requested. **Total cost of the Fellowship is \$8,500.00 per Fellow.** The fundraising efforts of LIDERAMOS allows for each agency to offer a discount for participants.
